Man Dies after being hit by car

A 27-year-old Orlando man died in Kissimmee early Thursday after being hit by a car on Airport Road, Kissimmee police said.

They identified the dead man as Michael R. Litteral, 1207 43rd St., Orlando.

Police said Adam D. Snyder, 18, 218 Nannette Drive, Orlando, was driving a 1978 Chevrolet north on Airport Road around 3 a.m. when he hit Litteral who was lying in the road.

Police speculated that Litteral had been drinking before the accident and had lain down in the middle of the road.

No charges have been filed against Snyder, but an investigation is continuing, police said.
