Born in Orlando on 3 Sept 1938, Bob was the son of Robert J. and Elizabeth (Stalder) Kieser. He attended Kaley Elementary, Cherokee Jr. High and was a graduate of Boone High School (1956). He was a member of Delaney St Baptist Church. He later graduated from Florida State University (1961) and received his Master's degree from Troy State in Alabama. He entered the Air Force after college and retired as a Major, specializing in training for the AWACS program.

Bob died on 9 May 2015 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 76, and was buried in Little Cemetery, Seminole County, Oklahoma. He was predeceased by his parents and brother, Charles David Kieser.
